Prayer Diary – September 2024

Sunday 1st	We meet together this morning at 9:30 at St Luke's 10:45 at St
September	Andrew's, and at 6:30 this evening at St Andrew's. Give thanks that
	we are free in this country to meet publicly to worship. Pray for
	Christians in countries where it's illegal.
	Christ Church Hessle, a new church plant in the Christ Church
	Network launches today. Pray that God would use this new faithful
	church to build up Christians in Hessle and to draw new people into a
	living relationship with Jesus. Ask God to provide their minister, Adam
	Johnston and the leadership team with all wisdom and godliness.
Monday 2 nd	Most children and teachers go back to school this week. Pray that
September	Christians in schools would live for Jesus this term, and have plenty
	of opportunities to share the gospel with their colleagues and
	classmates. Pray that Christian children starting new schools would
	be sure that God is with them.
Tuesday 3 rd	Praise God for the ministry of Friendly Community Spaces at St
September	Luke's each Tuesday. Pray that Christians who attend would be
	intentional about praying for and taking opportunities to share the
	gospel with non-Christians who also attend.
	We meet to pray at 7:45 for 8pm at the Memorial Hall this evening.
	Ask God to increase our churches' commitment to gathering for
	corporate prayer during the coming year.
Weds 4 th	Give thanks for St Luke's Toddler Group as it restarts after the
September	summer. Pray that one non-Christian connected to it would become
	a follower of Jesus this term.
	Praise God for the 10:30am BCP communion service . Give thanks
	for the new people he has drawn to us through it. Pray that he
	would continue to add to our number.
Thursday 5 th	Pray for those who work behind the scenes to make the churches
September	and the benefice run smoothly. Pray that they would always find joy
	in their part in the ministry.
Friday 6 th	Pray that Faith on Friday would be a source of spiritual growth and
September	encouragement for the ladies who attend.

	LaunchPad, Rockets and Impact all restart this afternoon and
	evening. Pray that all those who attended last term would return
	and bring a friend with them.
Saturday 7 th	Pray for Greg and Caroline as they are married at St Andrew's this
September	afternoon.
Sunday 8 th	We return to our series in 2 Corinthians this morning. Pray that
September	through it God would teach you and the whole church family more
	and more about the Lord Jesus, and that we would all grow in our
	confidence as his people.
Monday 9 th	The Bible Storytelling Team (formerly Open the Book) are in St
September	Andrew's School this morning and Carr Lane on Thursday. Pray that
-	God would open the hearts of the children and teachers to his word.
Tuesday 10 th	Praise God for Little Stars that restarts today. Pray that relationships
September	with families would continue to develop and that there would be
	plenty of opportunity to share the good news of Jesus with many.
	Growth Groups meet today, tomorrow, and Thursday, many of
	them for the first time after a summer break. Pray that each gets off
	to a good start and that all new members find a warm welcome.
Weds 11 th	Pray that a distinctly Christian community would once again develop
September	at St Luke's Toddler Group this school year.
	Give tanks for the BCP Communion Service at St Andrew's this
	morning, particularly the way in which it provides a spiritual home
	for d=some who can't make Sunday church, and provides midweek
	spiritual sustenance for others.
Thursday 12 th	Give thanks that the Mums' Book Group has grown over the
September	summer. Pray that all who attend would find useful wisdom in the
	book they're reading together, and meaningful friendships with
	other mums.
	It's Pub Night tonight in the Wheatsheaf. Give thanks for the
	possibility of meeting there for fellowship and conversation.
Friday 13 th	Give thanks for Sally Hopkinson (LaunchPad), Pete Hopkinson
September	(Rockets) and Ash Carter (Impact) as they head up each of these
	ministries among children and youth. Pray for energy, inspiration and
	continued diligence in prayer and practical matters for them this term.

Sunday 15 th	We meet today around God's word and his table this morning. Pray

Sunday 22 nd	Pray that we as church families would remember to always trust
September	only God even in a sometimes very messy world. Pray that as we

September	tomorrow. Pray that the conference would fulfil its role in advancing
	Anglican Evangelical ministries for the salvation of England by

	the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that they may know him
	better. I pray that the eyes of their hearts may be enlightened in
	order that they may know the hope to which he has called them, the
	riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his
	incomparably great power for us who believe.
